

#### **MOBILE PHONES**



The downloading of unregulated and inappropriate material and misuse of mobile phones is known to have undermined students' safety and wellbeing in a number of schools across the country.

From now on, to protect young people and in keeping with best practice in schools, any mobile phones which are brought into St Bart's by students are not to be used or seen during the school day. This applies not only to lessons, but to break and Activity Time.

Sixth Form independent study use will be permitted by staff, as appropriate.

In an emergency, if a parent needs to contact their child, they should phone the school switchboard number and ask to be put through to their child's House office. Students needing to contact home with an urgent message, should ask to ring from the House office.

These expectations are to protect all students from inappropriate material or unwanted messages and from having their photographs taken and potentially misused.

For most students there is no need to have a mobile phone in school. Students are advised to leave valuables at home.
