### WHAT IS AN ENTERPRISE ACTIVITY?

Enterprise activities need not involve actually running a business. In life, enterprising work goes on outside the confines of business activity. Therefore an enterprise activity is any learning experience with the following characteristics:

- Students have the freedom to decide the focus of the activity
- Students work in teams or alone, undertaking specific roles to complete tasks
- Students are asked to identify and obtain appropriate resources
- Students are given responsibility for managing the activity
- The activity reflects the constraints and practice of the adult business world
- The activity has a definite end result, which may be a product or a service

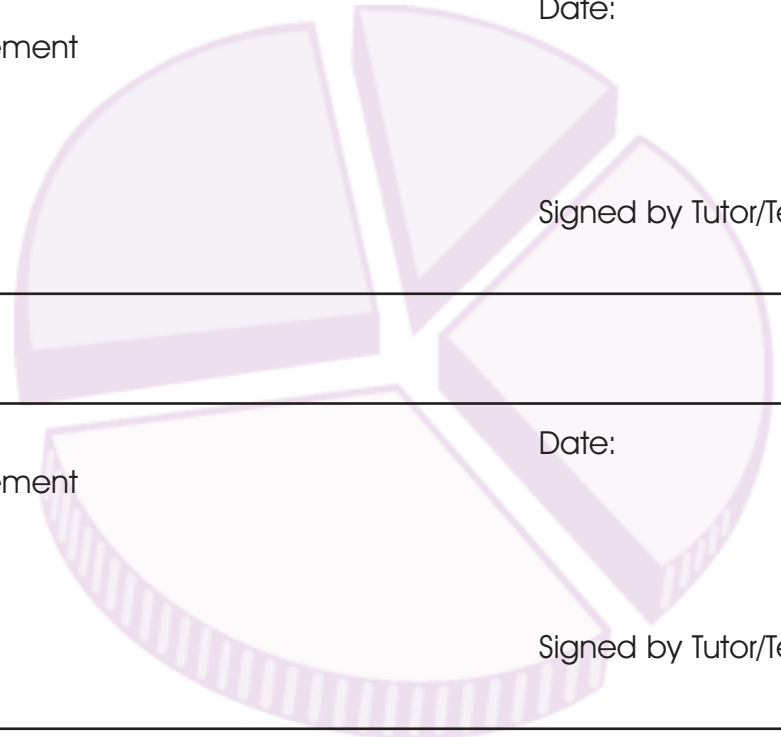
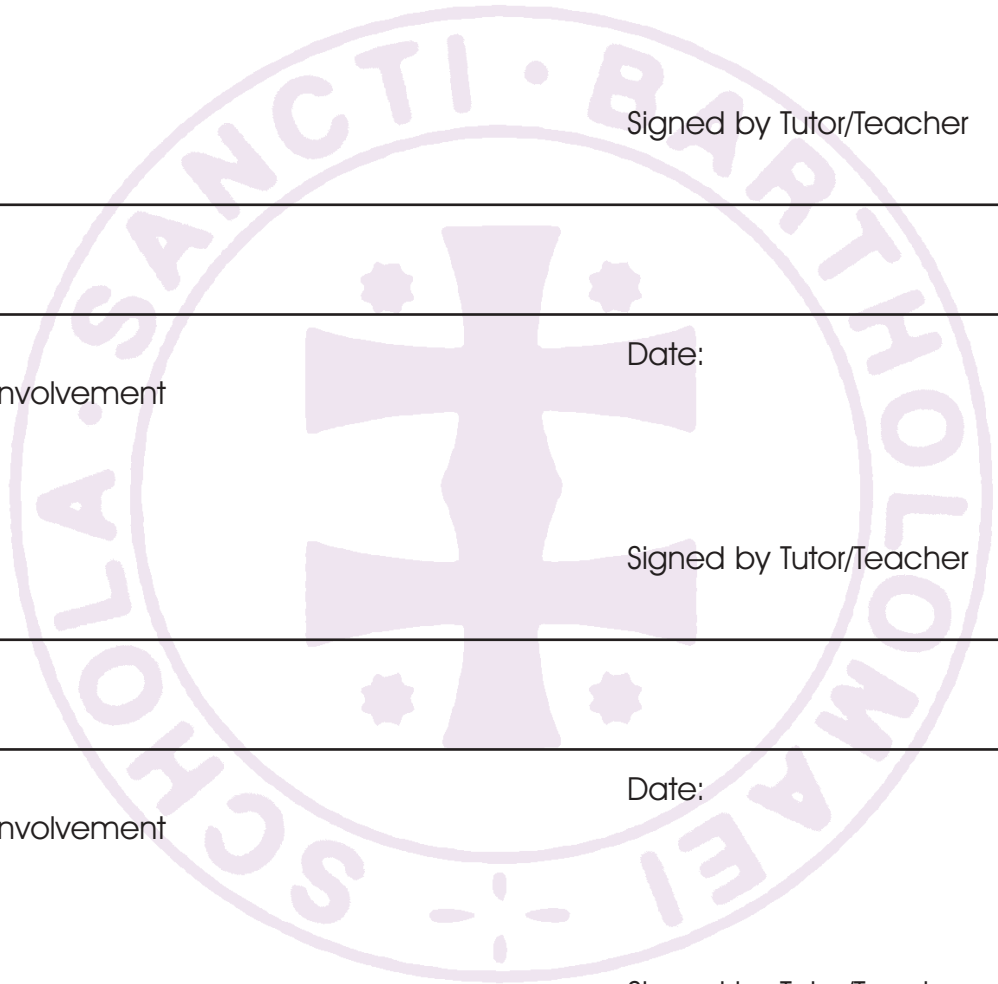
