Gruesome makeup effects were created with stage makeup during drama club last week and students enjoyed making some realistic bruises,

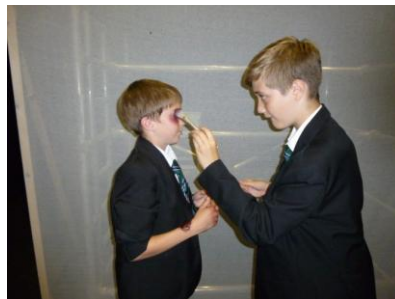


bullet wounds, cuts and scars. The club is organised by the drama department and supported by sixth form students.

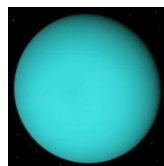
