UNIFORM

Please may we remind you that full school uniform must be worn to and from school on school days, and on day-time visits, away sports fixtures and by students on duty at school functions.

Students must keep their hair tidy and of reasonable length - this should not be exceptionally short or long. Hair dyed in unnatural or varied colours is not permitted, nor are extravagant hairstyles.

Make-up is not allowed in years 7 – 11, nor is coloured nail varnish.

In years 7 – 11, no jewellery or body piercing is allowed, apart from one plain stud or small ring in one or both ear lobes.

Shoes must be plain black, low heels (maximum heel height 5cm) and of formal design. Trainers are not permitted for daywear, other than PE.

All uniform items, except shirts to be worn with ties, shoes, socks and tights, are unique to the school. They are unique because they carry a discrete but visible school logo, which will ensure clarity for students, parents/carers and staff.

Pictures on the theme of 'OLD'

It seems that this particular theme did not capture your imagination as I have just one entry from Lucy Colston, so well done to her! I have, then, taken the opportunity to show some images on the same theme in the hope that they will get some of your creative juices flowing!



Lucy has sent in a lovely image showing 'old' in a beautiful ammonite fossil placed

on a far newer (but still 'old') wooden background. The light is coming a high enough angle to illuminate them both well, but also low enough that the ridges in the ammonite are, rather cleverly, repeated in its shadow. Combined with the focus point on the left of the fossil, the spiral then draws your eye in even further – an excellent technique!

The shots I chose show ...



A car. The reflections show shiny new paintwork but the style of the car is obviously old; just look at the handle and covered spare tyre on the boot!

Look again through the rear windows and you can see the old dashboard dials and even a small bunch of flowers! Now look through the windscreen and you can see that this is not just any old car ... the bonnet has 'The Spirit of Ecstasy' emblem ... from a Rolls Royce.

Gravestones. This is a dark image that contrasts some old warm, red brickwork with some equally old, but cold grey gravestones. The gravestones are obviously resting there and not marking the grave to which they belong. The image is clearly asking us ... where are the buried bodies now? Are they,

like the gravestones, kept safe, or have they been torn from the ground (like the gravestones themselves)?



A door. This is a simple image that also shows

contrasts: the stained and weather-beaten wooden door with its rusted hinge against the fact that it is an obviously well-built and strong object, still standing after many, many years. It also shows a lovely gradation of colour fading in the vertical wooden slats against the single, horizontal, almost mono-hued hinge; but look again to see the artistry in the hinge making with the slight curl in the leaf at the end!



A pier. The pier, once a grand place for people to visit, is now a ruin and can be

seen here, rather majestically rising from a rough sea. However, there is little detail to suggest its former glory and though the light clouds echo the shapes of the standing wrought iron work, and the light is reflecting from the sea, showing the crashing waves rather nicely, it all leaves the pier in dark, sad, silhouette.
