7C2, VOCABLICS CHAMPIONS!

This year, Year 7 tutor groups across all houses have entered a special vocabulary Olympics, called Vocablics, which challenges us to use more complex and exciting words, thereby expanding our vocabularies.

The words we learn are specifically chosen, not only for academic purposes, words like data and analysis, but also to improve daily communication, words like assume and similar. Some of the words will also prepare us for our future working lives: for example, context, derive and principle.

To help us, we are provided with a Vocablics booklet, which has a list of the words and their definitions. During PDP, we are encouraged to participate in games that help us to spell, pronounce and put the words into context. Personally, my favourite game is either Hangman or Charades. These games prepare us for the Vocablics quiz in which we can achieve a pass, merit or a distinction based on our knowledge and application of the words. At the moment, we are working on our bronze-level awards, with silver and gold to follow in future years. The tutor group with the highest points as a class (adding 3 for a distinction, 2 for a merit and 1 for a pass) wins a prize. My tutor group, 7C2, were the winners this half-term.
