We were very excited to discover a giant Clifden Nonpareil (meaning 'unrivalled') moth at Moth Club last week. This is a moth that Dr Fitter has been hoping to see for over 40 years with no luck. It is now only an immigrant to the British Isles and only a handful are seen every year. A favourite of the Victorian Moth enthusiast, the 'Blue underwing' is a magnificent moth with a wingspan of nearly 10cm and a striking blue band on the underwing.
