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### SCHOOL PERFORMANCE TABLES

Last week saw the publication of School Performance Tables by the Department for Education and I am

pleased to report that this again saw St Bart's in the top 8% of all state schools, including state selective schools (4,385 schools) for performance in terms of Progress 8 for all students.

This follows from the tremendous performance of our students last summer when 78% achieved five or more  $A^*$  - C grades at GCSE and 41% of all grades were  $A^*/A$  grades, the highest in the area.

These results are only made possible through the hard work and commitment of students and teachers, with the excellent support from families. These partnerships remain a priority for us and thank you for your support.

Building on this success we are now thrilled to have ever increasing numbers of students applying to the Sixth Form at St Bart's and interviews take place during the weeks beginning 6 February and 20 February.

However, as always, it is important to remember that St Bart's is about developing the full potential of every child. We encourage all students to participate in activities across the school, so please support your child to get involved wherever possible and take advantage of the wealth of opportunities here.
