Please can you check the balance on your child's lunch card and additional purchased printing credits before your son/daughter leaves St Bartholomew's School.

Where lunch card accounts are in debit and therefore money is owing to the school, please pay using ParentPay, or pay Mrs Angela Billingham in the kitchen between 8.00am and 8.30am, or in the Facilities Office between 2.00pm and 2.30pm by **Friday 12 May**; overdrafts won't be permitted after this date. Alternatively, the money can be left in a clearly labelled envelope at the school reception.
