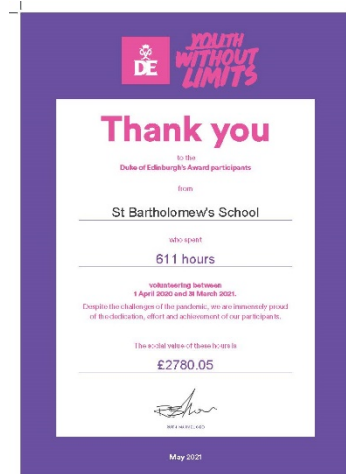
## YEAR 7 AND 8 ACTIVITY CAMP

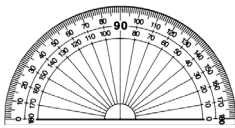

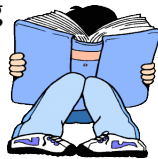
