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ST BART'S CELEBRATES EXAM SUCCESS

Following the two years of disruption to learning and exams as a result of the pandemic, St Bart's were recently able to celebrate the tremendous achievements of our Year 11 and Year 13 students who sat their public GCSE, BTEC and A level exams this summer.

We are so proud of both the students' and staffs' resilience and determination in the face of great challenges. The fantastic outcomes that the school have seen are testament to their dedication and hard work.

The A level and Level 3 BTEC results achieved by the Year 13 cohort were excellent. Nearly 80% of all grades were a C or better, and 30% were A or A*, with 41 students achieving at least 3 A*/A grades - a phenomenal achievement. Most importantly, the vast majority of students were able to continue their studies at their chosen university, start their apprenticeship or enter the world of employment. Our GCSE and L2 BTEC results were stunning. A remarkable 42% of all grades achieved were a grade 7, 8 or 9, which equate to at least an A grade, and some 72 students achieved at least 8 grades of a 7 or more. Nearly 90% of all of the grades were at least a 4 (old grade C) and we are thrilled that over 95% of students achieved at least a grade 4 in English and 87% in Maths. The great majority of students have this week joined us in the Sixth Form to continue their studies and to those that have chosen to move on to apprenticeships and college we wish them the greatest success.

#LetGirlsPlay Winners

The success of the Lionesses at the UEFA Women's EURO 2022 will have inspired many girls this summer. Amongst them will be Poppy and Abi (Year 11) who recently learnt they were to be the worthy recipients of an FA #LetGirlsPlay Award: following their nomination by the school for their work in supporting participation in the sport.

The Football Association's campaign, #LetGirlsPlay, calls for all girls to have equal access to football in schools by 2024. Research shared as part of the campaign shows that whilst football is the most popular team sport for young people in England, only a third of girls aged 5-18 years participate each week. The research findings also show that 90% of girls that play enjoy it, 60% of the girls that play football in schools want to play more and 91% of girls that do not play, want the opportunity to do so.

Having completed the Barclays Game on Activators course Poppy and Abi used their knowledge and understanding of the game to help motivate and inspire other girls to take part in football during activity times and after school, ensuring the sessions are accessible to all abilities. The school welcomed The FA last term so that they could film Abi and Poppy in action as they led a Year 9 lesson and Year 8 after school club. You can watch the video here.



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
