ACADEMIC SUCCESS

For the last 5 years St Bart's has secured the highest level of student attainment and progress in West Berkshire state schools. Our key headlines are:

- In 2022, 86% of our students achieved both GCSE English and Mathematics at level 4 or better and 42% of all grades were 9-7
- Over the last 5 years our average Progress 8 score has been 0.64 which put St Bartholomew's in the top 5% of schools nationally
- In 2022, A Level results were above national averages with 28% of all grades A*/A and 78% of all grades A*-C
