Alongside the fundraising, the committee meet twice per term, to which all parents are welcome. The meeting includes a Parent Forum Discussion, which have this year included PDP, Communication and Reading.

The PA has helped faculties to improve teaching facilities and continues to support our students via Year Councils and the subsidising of the school rewards system. Its valued support is immensely appreciated.
