Special Educational Needs and Disabilities/Personalised Learning

Personalised Learning supports students who have special educational needs through providing additional support over and above that which is usually provided in differentiated classroom activities.

Students are assessed on entry to the school, at intervals throughout their time with us and, subsequently, as the need arises. If a student is assessed as having additional learning needs then the student will receive additional support from the SENDCo, Mrs J Hale and our Personalised Learning team.

In order to support additional needs, the Teaching Assistants work with students on a one-to-one and small group basis within and beyond the classroom to support learning and social development. Intervention groups are also run to accelerate learning and progress in literacy and numeracy.
